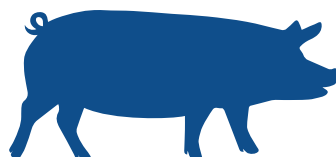


# EXPORTING INDIANA CORN THROUGH U.S. BEEF AND PORK

In 2022, the market value of beef and pork exports to

**Indiana Corn = \$241.21 million**

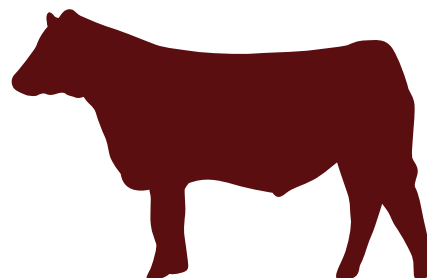
(corn consumed by beef and pork exports at average corn price)  
35.73 million bushels x \$6.75 per bushel



In 2022 beef and pork exports contributed

**15% of bushel value = \$1.01**

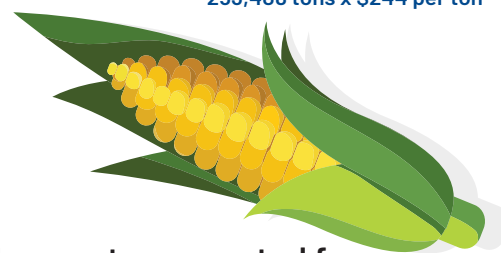
at an average price of \$6.75 per bushel



In 2022, the market value of beef and pork exports to

**Indiana DDGS = \$61.83 million**

(corn consumed by beef and pork exports at average DDGS price)  
253,408 tons x \$244 per ton



Beef and pork exports accounted for

**3.42 million tons of U.S. DDGS in 2022**

U.S. beef and pork exports contributed

**\$191.90**  
per Indiana  
Corn acre

at \$1.01/bushel at a yield of  
190 bushels/acre in 2022

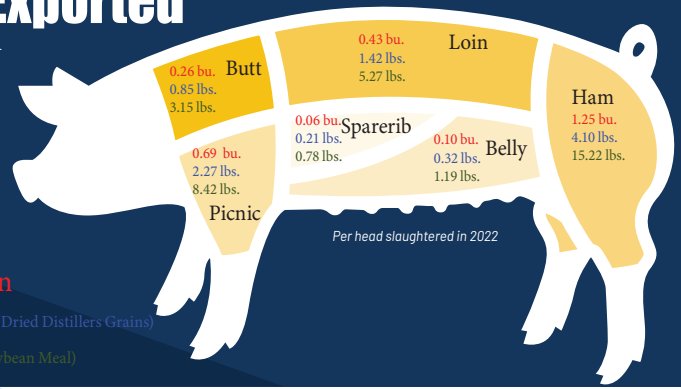
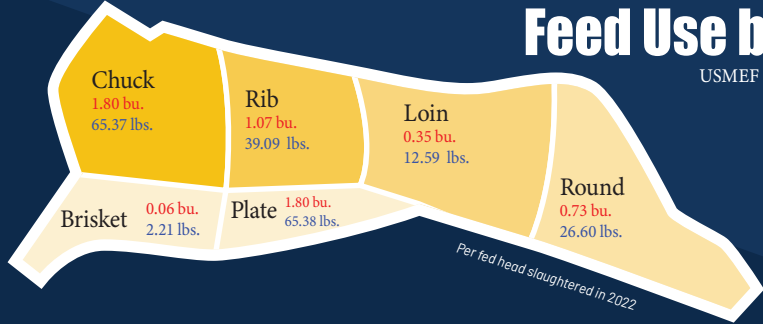


Beef and pork exports accounted for

Lbs. of DDGS (Dried Distillers Grains)

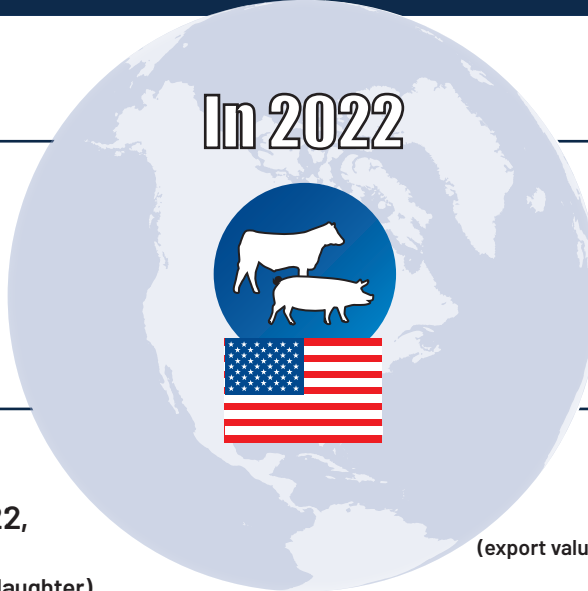
Lbs. of SBM (Soybean Meal)

Beef export value equated to **\$447.58 per head** of fed cattle slaughtered in 2022, a new record (export value divided by 2022 fed cattle slaughter)

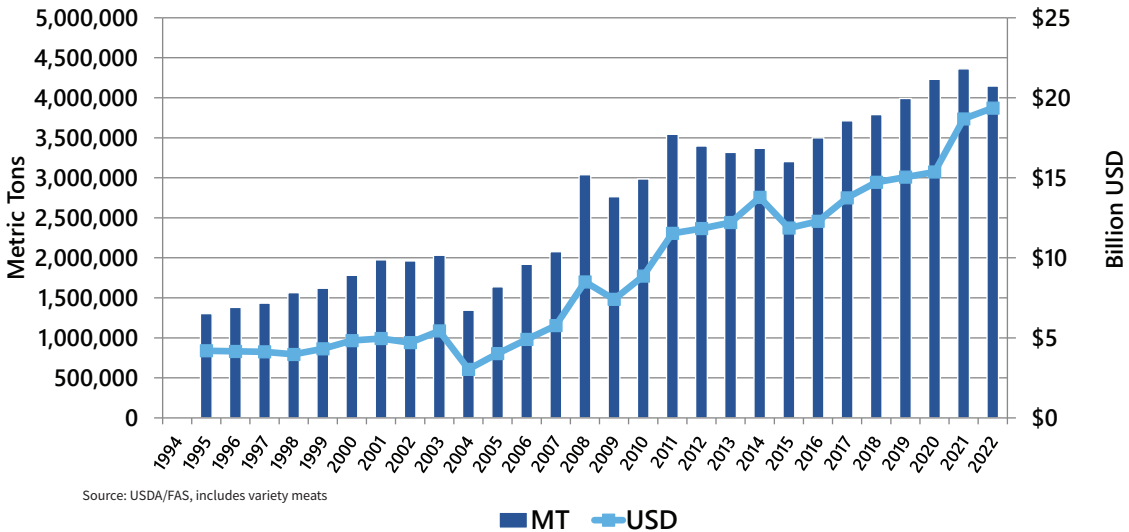


**27.5%** of U.S. pork and pork variety meat production was exported



Pork export value equated to **\$61.26 per head** slaughtered in 2022 (export value divided by 2022 commercial hog slaughter)
